
Determining Readability Using WordPerfect

WordPerfect documents can be analyzed for their readability by using WordPerfect's Grammatik tool. Readability refers to the skill level (i.e. U.S educational levels 1-16) required for the reader to understand the text. For example, a score of 8.0 means that an eighth-grader can understand the document.

Grammatik analyzes the readability of a document by comparing the text with a comparison document. You can choose from one of three Grammatik comparison documents, or you can add a custom comparison document if you have a document whose reading level you wish to match.
